

2019 Camp Alexander Reservation Form

MUST READ AND SIGN PRIOR TO REGISTERING

Camp Alexander receives a high volume of reservations for summer camp each year. In order to ensure we serve the maximum number of youth the following polices must take place:

- **Your unit may be required to move campsites based on the number of scouts you bring.**
- **Your unit may be asked to bring their own personal tents for some or all adults to accommodate more scouts to attend camp.**
- **Your unit could potentially share a campsite with another unit based on your registration numbers.**
- **I understand my unit must pay the Merit Badge Fees after Merit Badge Registration (May 8th) by May 20th, 2019 or all classes will be removed and will need to reregister.**

In order to secure your first campsite, we recommend that you bring as close to (but not over) the maximum number of scouts (youth) for the campsite

All monies paid to Pikes Peak Council are non-refundable in the event of a cancelation. Units are strongly encouraged to collect the money from the campers prior to confirming their attendance at camp and informing them that there are no refunds.

Refund Policy - Any time a unit does not meet the payment schedule, the unit risks losing its reservation, including all monies paid up to that point. All monies paid to Pikes Peak Council are non-refundable at any time. Monies paid by the unit are transferable between campers IN THAT UNIT before the final payment date of May 8, 2019. If a Scout/Scouter cancellation occurs AFTER the May 8, 2019 payment date, NO fees will be refunded unless documented by a medical doctor, military deployment or a death occurred in the family. All refund requests MUST submit the refund request form found in the Program Guide AND MUST BE RECEIVED by August 3, 2019. For information about obtaining a refund, please contact Pikes Peak Council at 719-219-2907 or at cameron.ackley@scouting.org. **All refunds are subject to a minimum of \$75.00 cancellation fee after May 8th 2019. Refunds are only given for registration fees. Refunds will not be given Merit Badges, Rafting, or any other additional fees.**

Once your payment has been made, you will have an account created through our online registration system. You will be e-mailed your login information. At that point, all payments and Merit Badge registrations will be through that account.

- May 8th – Full amount (Merit Badge Registration Day)
- **May 20th – Merit Badge Fees Due**

Merit Badge Registration

Our Merit Badge registration system will only open for those units that have **paid their registration fees in full by 5:00 PM MDT May 8th**. A guide on how to register for merit badges will be published in the Program Guide for the summer. After you have registered for Merit Badges, you will need to pay the Merit badge Fees by May 20th, 2019.

Tight fairways, undulating greens and beautiful views will make your day fun and exciting. The views of Pikes Peak and other surrounding mountains are breathtaking!

- Bring your own clubs if possible!
 - Some (minimal) rental clubs are available at no extra cost
 - Tee times are 10:00 am, 10:10 am & 10:20 am
 - Range balls are included
 - Lunch is included
 - 2 Drink coupons for any drink of your choice included
 - The course is very tight so we will play a "Modified Scramble." All players drive from tee box. Select the best drive and each player plays their own ball from there.
 - Best score gets a prize!
 - The temperature is usually a gorgeous 75 – 85 degrees. Shorts are recommended and you might want to bring a light jacket
